Discussion and possible action to authorize County Attorney to take the necessary steps including, the filing of a lawsuit to recover reimbursement amounts from all applicants (not County Employees) who requested and received funds from the Weatherization Assistance Program, who did not qualify for the Weatherization Assistance Program according to eligibility guidelines and other matters incident thereto. **[Closed Session is requested pursuant to Texas Government Code, Title 5, Subchapter D, Section 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney)]**
