
J. B. Alexander Boys Baseball Team made the Final Four State Finalist. Congratulations to them all.


- The progress of the Community Action Agency

Happy Birthday Blas Garza! Blas is the security for our county courthouse and he celebrated his 51st birthday June 17th




Lalo Uribe, Webb County Executive Administrator, celebrated his 41st on June 27th. Happy Birthday Lalo!
