Webb County Immunization Clinics in El Cenizo, Texas

Webb County will be holding back to school vaccine clinics at the El Cenizo Community Center located at 3519 Cecilia Lane, El Cenizo, Texas on:

- Friday, August 7, 2015 from 2 pm to 6 pm
- Monday, August 10, 2015 from 8 am to 12 pm (noon)

These clinics are being coordinated by the Webb County Indigent Health Care Services Department as part of the settlement agreement between Webb County and the Comite de Ciudadanos Unidos de El Cenizo.

The immunization clinic is open to the residents of El Cenizo and no administrative fee will be assessed.

Vaccines will be available to provide protection against:

In accordance with TVFC guidelines, children, age 18 and under with Medicaid or no insurance are eligible. Children with private insurance or CHIP will be referred to their Medical Provider

Parents/legal guardians will need to provide the child's immunization record to confirm which vaccines will be administered.
