Webb County Sheriff's Deputies Cracking Down on Drunk Driving and Underage Drinking this Weekend

Laredo, Texas (Webb County) - The Webb County Sheriff's Highway Patrol will be out in full force cracking down on drunk driving and underage drinking this Fourth of July weekend.

"Alcohol impairment remains a significant factor in fatal motor vehicle crashes in the state. Not only are you endangering your life but the life of someone else, plus the trauma and the financial costs of a crash or an arrest for driving while impaired can be significant.

If you're caught driving impaired, you will be arrested" said Sheriff Martin Cuellar.

Driving while either intoxicated or drunk is dangerous and drivers with high blood alcohol content or concentration (BAC) are at greatly increased risk of car accidents, highway injuries and vehicular deaths. Possible consequences include suspending or revoking driver licenses, impounding or confiscating vehicle plates, impounding or immobilizing vehicles, penalties such as fines or jail for drunk driving, and mandating alcohol education.

“Too many people still don’t understand that drinking and driving don’t mix. Being responsible may save your life and the lives of others” stated Sheriff Martin Cuellar.
