Trautmann International Park Ribbon Cutting



Webb County Commissioner Jerry Garza, joined by the Commissioners Court and board members from UISD, held the ribbon cutting ceremony for the Trautmann International Park. Commissioner Garza saw the need to improve the quality of life for the residents and worked in conjunction with UISD to make his dream a reality. The park, currently in phase 1, will provide residents of north Laredo with a walking and jogging trail, basketball courts, and a football field. Future plans include a soccer field, tennis courts, a skateboard park, and a playground.

Time And Attendance Workshop

The Webb County Time and Attendance Committee, chaired by Commissioner Jerry Garza, held a two-day workshop for elected officials, department heads, and payroll supervisors to begin familiarizing them with the new system that the county will be integrating. Attendees were guided, as both employee and supervisor, through the features that the system will have. Attendees were able to express their concerns and questions to the committee. The committee welcomed all the feedback and said that they were grateful for the participation of everyone in attendance.





School Land Fund Check Presentation

Webb County Judge Danny Valdez and the Commissioners Court presented more than eight-hundred thousand dollars in checks to area school districts. LISD, UISD and the Webb Consolidated School District were presented with checks that are part of the Permanent School Land Fund, an arrangement in which the County acts as a land trustee for the school districts. Revenues raised came from 10,000 acres of school land in the north part of the County. The revenues on the land come from cattle grazing, hunting leases, petroleum royalties or anything else is automatically turned over to the school districts according to size and need. United Independent School District received \$553,679.96, Laredo Independent School District received \$320,782.84 and Webb Consolidate Independent School District received \$4,394.29.



Women Build Event

Webb County Commissioner Rosaura "Wawi" Tijerina and 10 Female members of her Community Involvement Team participated in a Women Build Event for Habitat for Humanity. The team assisted Habitat for Humanity at the Tierra Prometida subdivision located on Hwy 359 behind the Webb County Self Help Center. The group helped build a home for a qualified Habitat family. The Women Build Program also works to empower the women working on the homes.
